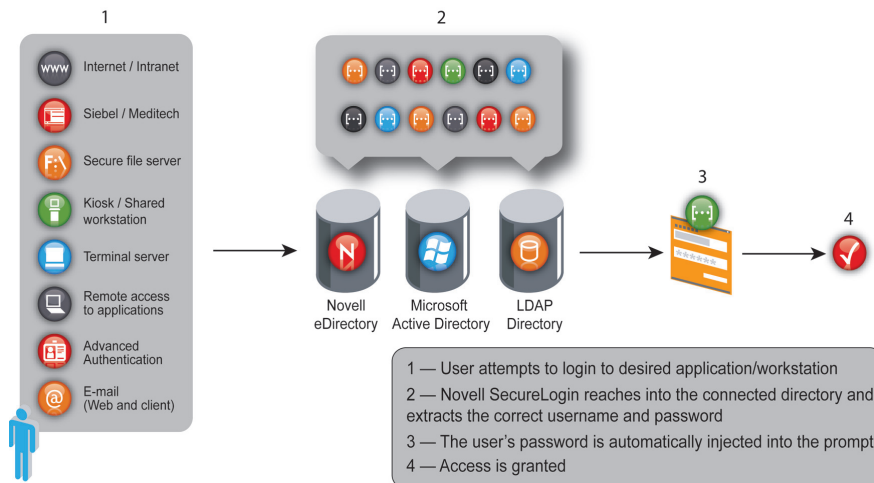


Figure 1. The heart of single sign-on
